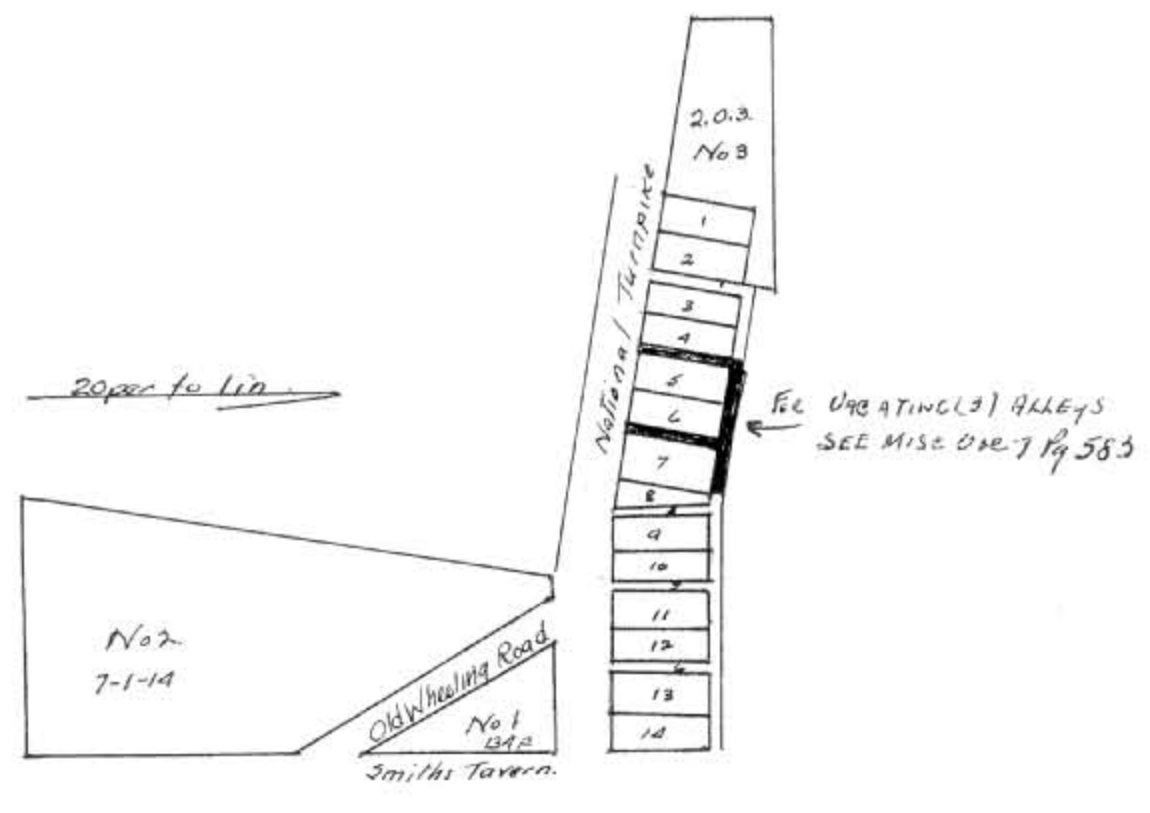


ADD. TO ELIZABETHTOWN



Restoration of Public Records

laid out on the National Turnpike on the 7th of Mar. 1832. Proprietor Jacob Weller. beginning at a stone north of said Pike & west of Blaensmiths shop. Said shop stands in SE cor. of 1/2 lot No 2. bearing on part of pike $579^{\circ}E$. 132 ft & 165 ft back at right angles including 1 1/2 lots. The back part of 1/2 of lot No 2 reserved thence commencing East of said shop on 1/2 lot bearing on part of said pike $580^{\circ}1/4^{\circ}E$ each lot in succession. 66 ft in front & 165 ft back. each alley 16 1/2 ft wide whole number of lots laid off is 7. No. of alleys. 3. National Road 4.8 rods wide back alley. 20 ft wide The above laid out south of turnpike commencing at a stone between said Prop. & Smith. thence S. 22.04 per thence N $28^{\circ}3/4^{\circ}W$. 25 per. & 12 hundredths. Thence east 12.16 per to beginning contains 134 per. lot No 2 beginning at a stone west of the old Wheeling road & adjacent the pike thence S. $27^{\circ}1/2^{\circ}E$. 34.6 per. South 27.8 per. thence west 28 per. thence North $8^{\circ}3/4^{\circ}E$. 59 per. thence East 2.80 per. to beginning contains 7 acres. 1 rood & 14 per. S $9^{\circ}1/4^{\circ}W$ 165 ft. contains 27.3 per. thence commencing east of the first alley in the addition marked No 4. & east of said lot No 8 thence bearing in front parallel with pike due east in progression to lot No 14. such lots excepting lot No 8 are 66 ft in front at right angles. due north 165 ft back. contain 1/4 acre also a large lot laid off on the west end of town. No 3 commencing at the S.E. cor of 1/2 lot No 2. N $80^{\circ}W$ 8 per. N $79^{\circ}W$ 19.6 per. North 8.10 per. thence south 29.68 per.
